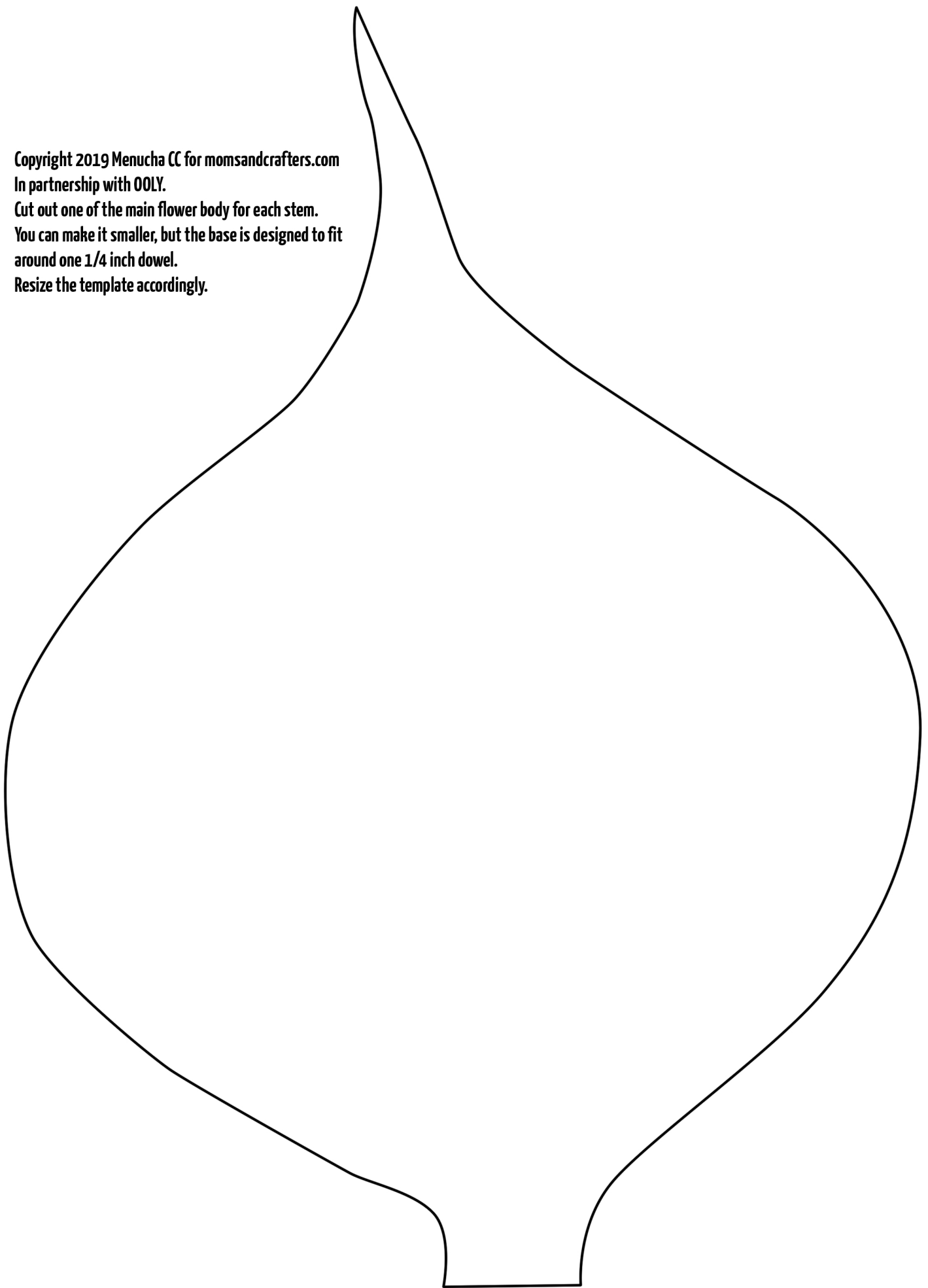


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In partnership with OOLY.  
Cut out one of the main flower body for each stem.  
You can make it smaller, but the base is designed to fit  
around one 1/4 inch dowel.  
Resize the template accordingly.



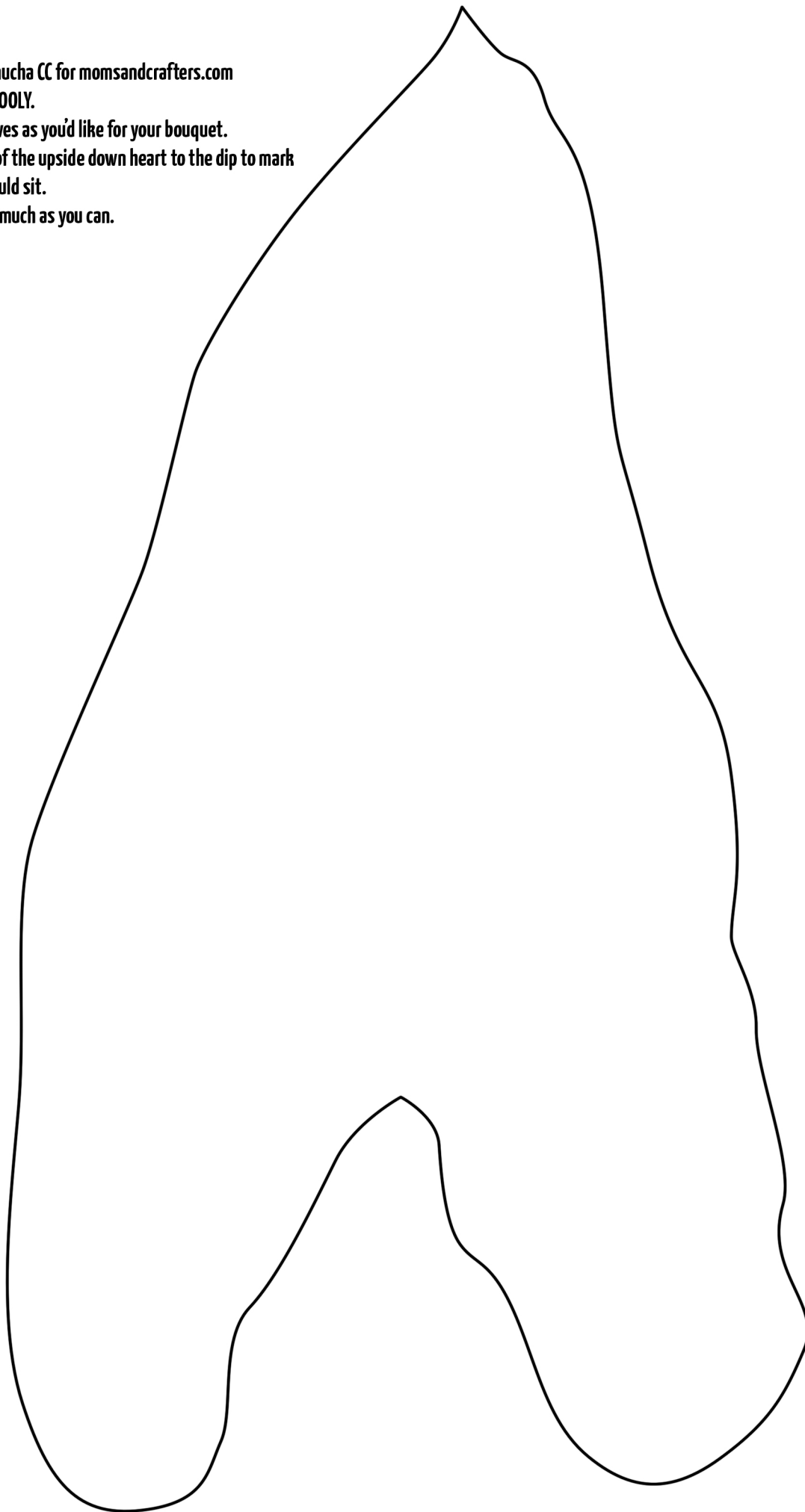
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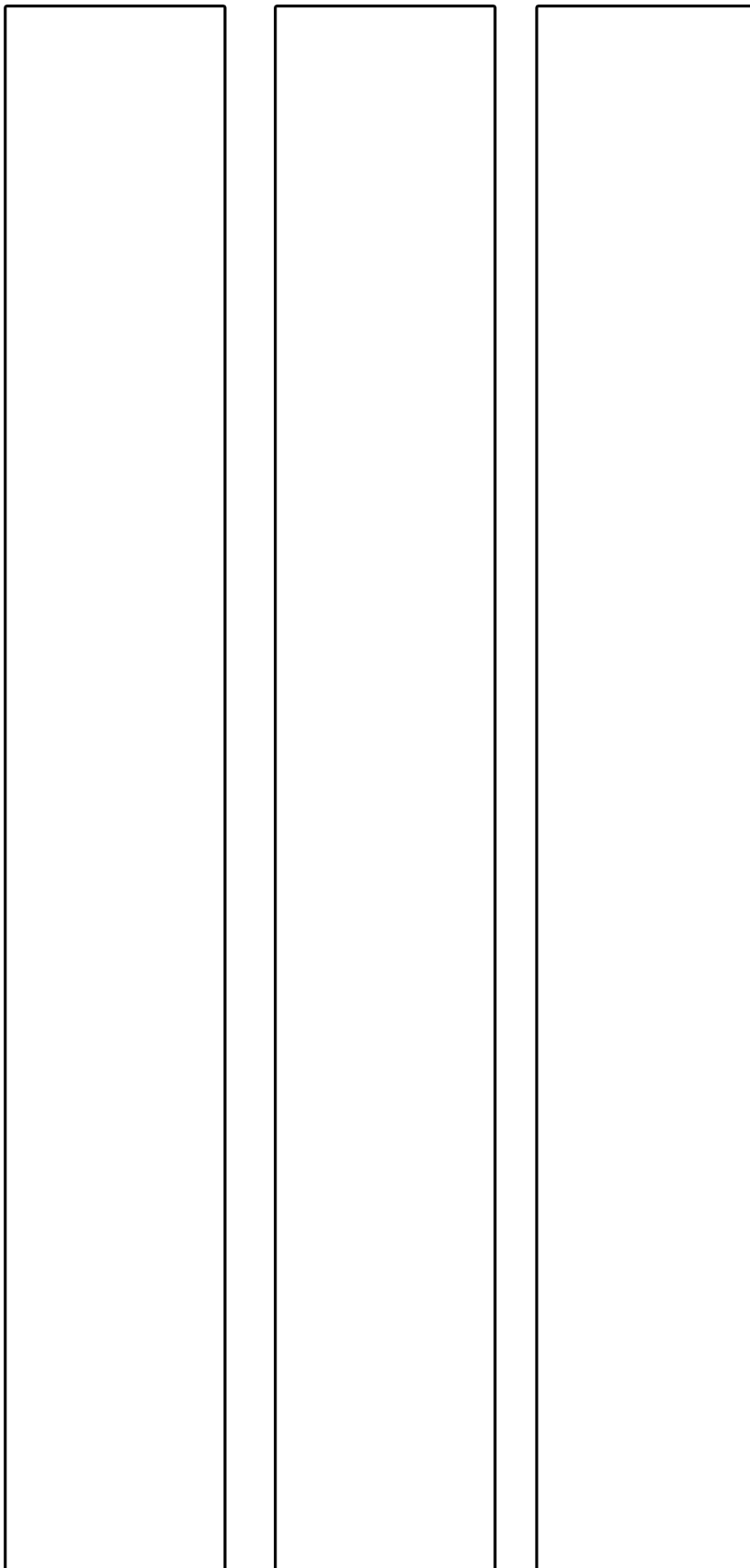
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Cut out as many leaves as you'd like for your bouquet.

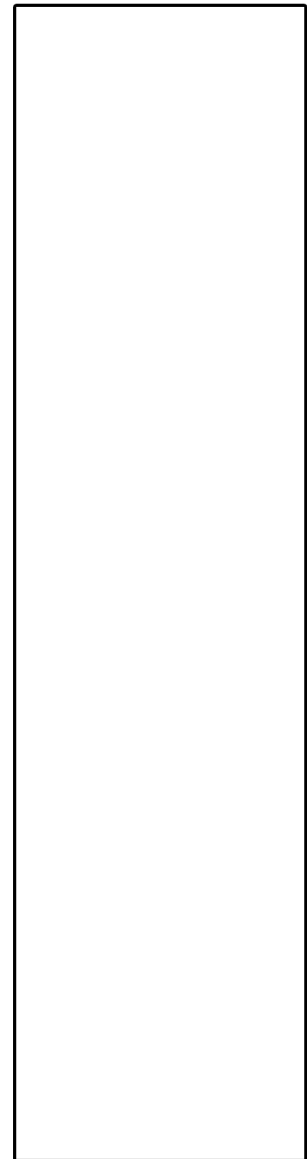
Fold it from the tip of the upside down heart to the dip to mark where the stem should sit.

Ruffle the edges as much as you can.





**Stamen:** designed to curl around the tip of a 1/4 inch dowel with a little leeway. You can curve the tip after you put your calla lily together.



**Dowel cover:** paint the dowels directly, or create watercolor art to cover them with. These are designed to fit around the 1/4 inch dowel with a drop of leeway just in case. They are nine inches long - use as many as you need, depending on the size of your dowel.
